OSPI LifeSkills Grant Opportunity

Purpose:

Support implementation of LifeSkills Training Middle School Curriculum in school setting or community-based organization (after-school like Boys & Girls Club)

Program:

Evidence-based program that helps students:

- enhance their self-esteem
- develop problem-solving abilities
- reduce stress and anxiety
- manage anger
- overcome shyness
- communicate clearly
- build relationships
- avoid violence and
- Develop refusal skills to prevent and reduce the use of marijuana

Level One (15 Sessions), Level Two (10 Sessions), and Level Three (5 Sessions)
Typically delivered to 6th, 7th and 8th graders over the course of 3 years.

PURPOSE

 - Contribute to the development of coalition strategic plans
- Monitoring & trends – what has changed?
 - Evaluation
 - Contribute to biennial strategic plan updates
 - Early indicator of change
- To develop a statewide convenience sample profile
 - Inform planning, campaigns, outreach
