---

A group process you facilitate that leads members from a basic understanding of new data to making decisions based on that data.

## Rapid Reflection: Four Questions

---

1. What type of data are we looking at?
2. What are we seeing?
3. What does it mean?
4. What should we do about it?

## Rapid Reflection: Four Questions

---

1. What type of data are we looking at?
  - a. What is the data being charted?  
*[unit of measure]*
  - b. How is the data being charted?  
*[type of graph]*

## Rapid Reflection: Four Questions

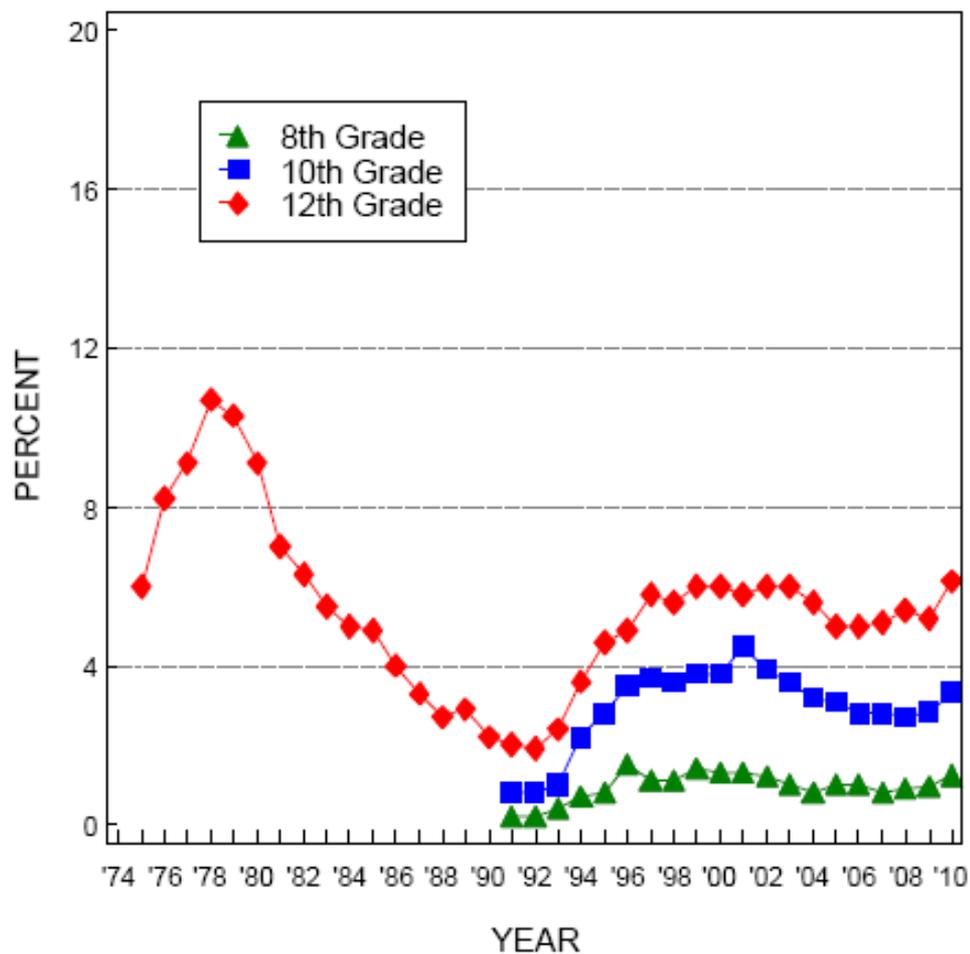
---

1. What type of data are we looking at?
  - c. Who does the data describe?  
*[the 'n' or population]*
  - d. When were the data collected?  
*[time period]*

## Rapid Reflection: Four Questions

---

### 2. What are we seeing?

#### a. What pattern are we seeing?

*[trends or distribution]*

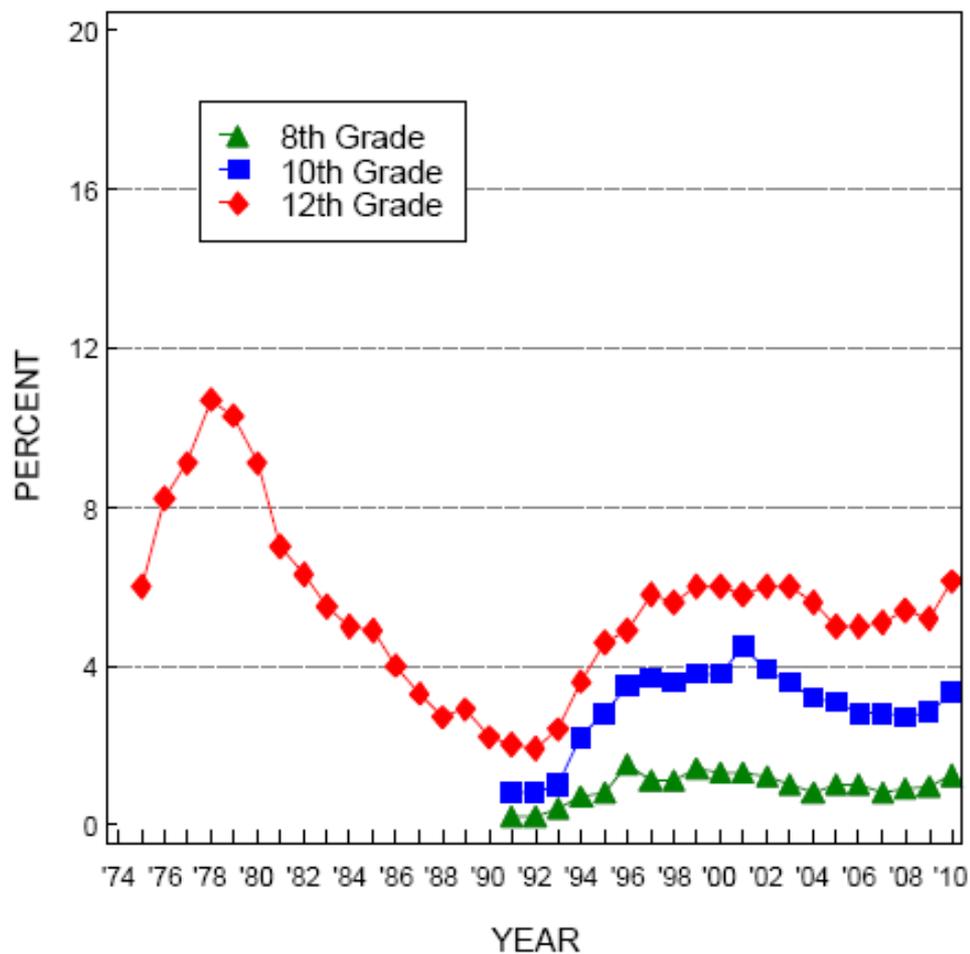
#### b. When or where is the data different than this overall pattern?

*[discontinuity]*

## Rapid Reflection: Four Questions

---

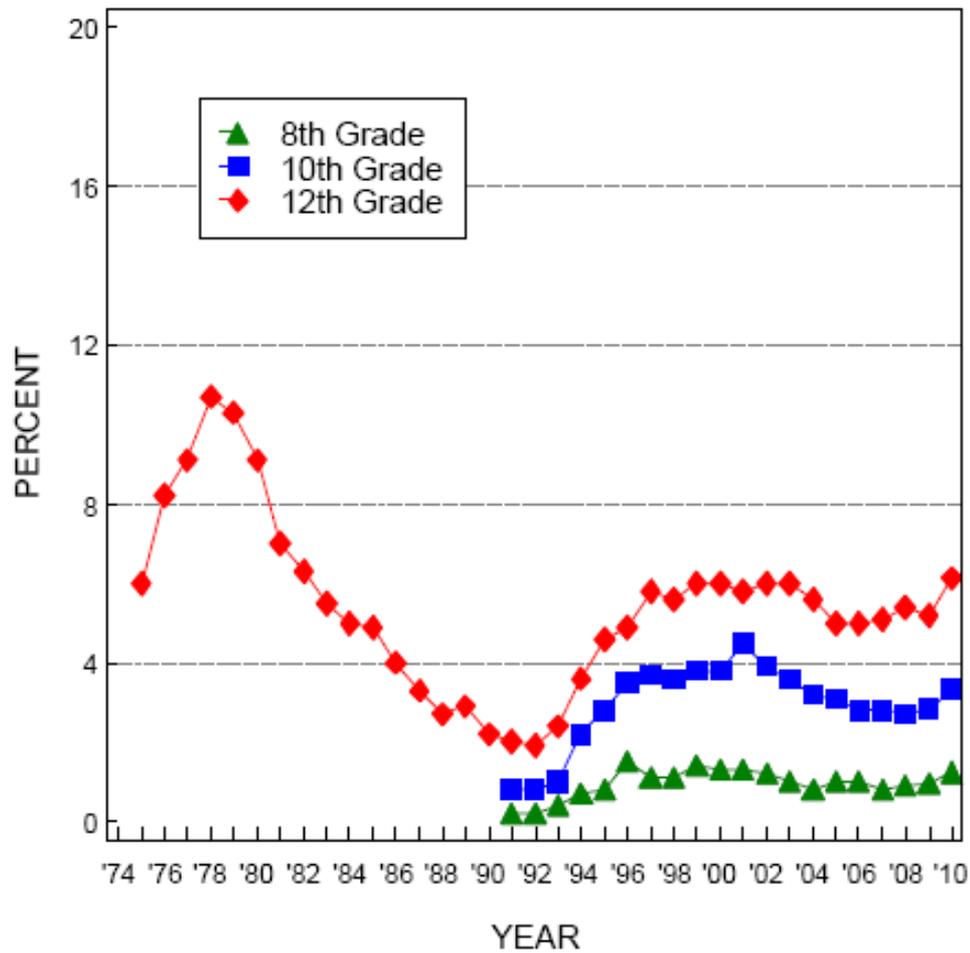
### 3. What does it mean?

- a. Is the pattern what we expected?  
*[compared to theory or our plan]*
- b. Why do we think the pattern is happening?  
*[underlying causes and influences]*
- c. What additional information do we need to fully understand the pattern?

## Rapid Reflection: Four Questions

---

4. What should we do about it?
  - a. Given what we have seen, what adjustments should we make in our work?  
*[improvement]*
  - b. Given what we have seen, who else should know about our conclusions?  
*[coordination]*

---

4. What should we do about it?
  - c. Given what we have seen, what can be said about our ability to achieve outcomes?  
*[accountability]*
  - d. Given what we have seen, what can we celebrate about our work?  
*[celebration]*
