<p>Training and Task Categories</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Getting started – register on The Athena Forum.</li> <li>- Notify Media – we have a template you can use to let your community know about your PRI funding and goals.</li> <li>- Capacity - Key leader orientation event -coalitions tend to be more successful when they start off with a unified understanding of how everyone will go forward (common language, theory, roles, etc).</li> <li>- If these coalitions can also reach out to key leaders in their community, they are more successful.</li> <li>- The tasks will be done over time, with guidance on when they should happen</li> <li>- Timeline overview is a suggestion on when to logically roll items out</li> <li>- Training Plan – Key leader is one of the onsite trainings; needs assessment training module; community planning. Your DBHR PRI Manager will provide assistance as needed, or will find someone to provide T.A.</li> <li>- These tasks will become part of your strategic plan.</li> </ul>

First hour will be Cohort 1, second hour will be DBHR business for both Cohorts, third hour is for Cohort 2.</p> <p>Marcia: Are we still having the All Provider meeting? Yes, it will be combined.</p> <p>PRI name: when we come up with a name that better describes what we are doing and where we are going, the name will change. If you have ideas about renaming the initiative, let DBHR know.</p>

Questions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Are the data sources or priority list for communities going to be revised? DBHR: The 2010 information will be in there – we are talking about increasing the weight of the substance abuse prevalence data, so this part will change, as well as the updated data.</li><li>• When going through the data process, will DBHR weigh indicators? DBHR: We are creating our composite scores differently, so if you are missing parts of the data, the final composite scores will be more balanced.</li><li>• Spokane: Is this data now available on Athena? DBHR: It will be handed out at the meeting in Yakima in Oct.</li><li>• 105: We are interested in seeing how the data will look for our county – we have been looking at the Athena site data and looking ahead.</li><li>• 189: We want to be clear on the cash match – do we ask for 20 percent ? DBHR: Yes.</li><li>• 171: Who do we work with on the cash match? DBHR: Work with the ESD.</li></ul>
