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Partnerships For Success (PFS)

- Review your Award and Revenues page for PFS allocation breakouts.
- Allocations are broken out into 3 month and 9 month increments to align with State Fiscal Year Contract dates.
 - Calculated using annual PFS allocation from Year 1 divided by 12 to get monthly amounts, then x3, x9.
- Pay special attention to the PFS allocations and spend down as they cannot roll forward.

Unallowable Partnerships for Success (PFS) Costs

 - Honorariums

 - Miscellaneous expenses
