

# CPWI funding adjustment

- ▶ Based upon your feedback, we have been advocating for increased funding from a more stable funding source.
- Intent of funding adjustment is to provide an adjustment to coalition coordinator salaries/benefits or increase program services.
  - ► Coalitions should have a voice in this process.
  - ▶ Funds may be used for other purposes as agreed upon by the coalition.
- Receiving admin as part of this allocation is an option.
- \*Note, this funding is not guaranteed until in contract.

# **CPWI Contract Template**



## The why

- Commitment to **high-quality prevention services** to include contracting documents that reflect this.
- At the start of the biennium we faced some bumps in the road!
- Over the last year we've been working to create the best version of our contract.
- By setting up a good template now, we do not anticipate major changes at the start of the next biennium.
  - Possibility to just amend the contract at the start of the biennium to allocate new funds rather than execute brand new contracts.



## Funding timelines vary

- SFY: July 1 June 30 annually
  - Dedicated Marijuana Account (DMA)
  - General Fund State (GFS or SFG)
- ▶ FFY: September 30 September 29 annually
  - Partnership for Success (PFS)
  - ➤ State Opioid Response (SOR) ends on 9/29/2020
- ▶ Biennium: July 1, 2019 June 30, 2021
  - SABG
- ▶ NEW timeline starting 2020: September 1 August 30 annually (for two years)
  - State Opioid Response (SOR) II



# The new template

#### What's changed?

- Contract layout/structure.
  - Including fixing formatting issues!
  - Less duplicity and more streamlined.
  - ▶ Goal was for a contract that was easy to read and look-up clauses as needed.
- Removing unnecessary and nonrequired requirements/clauses.

#### What hasn't changed?

- Intent and scope of contract including the Statement of Work.
- Similar language/clauses.



## Anticipated timeline

- Contractors who are not interested in receiving the COLA, communicate this (by community) to their PSM by **July 30**<sup>th</sup>.
- CPWI contract template in-process of being finalized by the Office of Contracts and Procurement and the Prevention Section with a goal of getting a draft for review to CPWI contractors by **early August**.
  - \*Note, any documents viewed/shared are a draft and are subject to change pending further review by HCA.
- Feedback on CPWI contract template by mid-August.
- Contracts out for signature by end of August.
