#### **Did You Know?**

- It takes only six hours of behind the wheel drive time with a Washington licensed driving instructor to get a probationary license. Yet, a cosmetologist must complete 2000 hours of training to be licensed in WA!
- Teen drivers are at the highest risk. The crash rate (per mile driven) for 16 year olds is four times that of adult drivers.
- Having passengers is a serious distraction for teen drivers. Carrying 3 or more passengers increases the risk of a crash for 16 and 17 year olds three-fold compared to driving alone.
- Studies show that a young driver's risk of being involved in a car crash is highest in the first 12-24 months of licensure.
- Graduated Drivers Licensing laws have reduced teen driving fatalities by 30-50% across the U.S.
