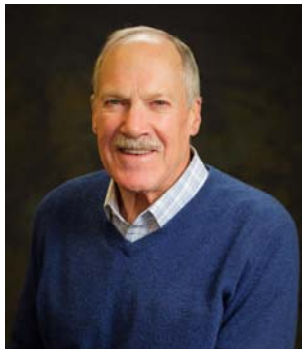


Impact Science Series: Spotlight on “Unleashing the Power of Prevention”
